1. **Membership Report:**
 - a. 229 members, 120 households, 46 new households and 79 new members to date
 - b. In the future, the Membership Director will email the list of members to Race Directors
2. **Treasurer's Report:**
 - a. \$7600 current balance
3. **John Carpenter with Animas Events:**
 - a. John proposed a sub chapter of DMT in Farmington. The club would be self sufficient and work from funds generated by their own members. The insurance and club affiliation with RRCA would be under the umbrella of DMT. John will look into finding committee members and gauging interest.
