



River Run For Orphans



What happens at a River Run for Orphans?

- 5 K (3.1 mile) run / walk – (strollers and wheelchairs encouraged).
- One mile run for kids. Start the 5K and 1 mile with a shofar.
- Participants submit pre-collected monies designated for the orphan organization or specific project of their choice. In this way money is raised for orphans locally and worldwide.
- Churches, community groups, schools, and individuals will not only be working to raise funds but also raise awareness by participating in “Orphans Around the World”, and facilitating fun and educational activities.
- “Orphans Around the World” is a collection of booths highlighting orphan organizations and projects. People may be able to sign up to sponsor a child, start the process to adopt a child, or fund a specific project to empower those in need.
- The money raised from business sponsors will go to specific projects, such as digging wells for clean and safe water, sponsoring teachers, helping people start a business, providing food, books, health care, clothing, and housing .
- Event activities may include – music, bounce houses, drama, crafts from around the world, special food, raffles, balloon rides, dunk tank, hay rides, crafts, and games.
- Prizes given to the top individual fundraisers
